- Strong dark beer of the bock family, with an extract content of 15.1% by wt. and an alcohol content of 6.5% by vol.
- A lovely ruby red colour, Koźlak has a distinctive hoppy caramel flavour.
- Brewed by traditional methods.
- Koźlak comes in a bottle with a glasspainted label, unique on the Polish market.
- Users of www.browar.biz, which is the biggest Polish portal for beer lovers and connoisseurs, recognised Koźlak as the best strong dark beer of all dark beer brands produced in Poland in 2004, 2<u>005, 2006</u>
